With the declaration that Covid-19 has become a worldwide pandemic, Malvern College continues to follow Public Health England's advice and our position will be updated here and on our social media channels. Our current parent community will be updated via email.

Update: Monday 16th March 10:00AM.

With immediate effect Malvern College will operate a core-business only model, focusing on lessons and internal co-curricular activities. Any external trips or fixtures will be individually assessed and pupils will not be compelled to take part. All overseas trips have been cancelled up until May 2020, with future trips being individually evaluated.

Malvern College has put in place appropriate isolation contingency plans should any pupil or member of staff require it.

Both staff and pupils have been briefed in distance learning should that become necessary. Staff are expecting to include all pupils in the work that is set.

We are expecting to continue to teach, and all pupils to complete work, until the normal end of term.

Given that schools in other countries have been forced to close, if at some point the UK follows suit, it is important for you to know that we will ensure that all pupils who cannot return home will be cared for by the College. Examination boards are considering possible alternatives to this summer's exams and we will keep you informed when decisions are made. We remain confident that no pupil will ultimately be disadvantaged.
